
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Silly Yellow Ducks Now Eat Yams


went in the store, and he was hungry because he went to the fruit.




this will take us! They need to wake up or it will be the end of mankind. They help us with our food.


When he was fin-

Other scientists say when you throw the peel I


the trash, it gets rid of the disgusting odor.

There was one of the unicorns at the Dummy Zoo and he ate 20 rabbits and one kid. After the unicorn was done he was so fat that he could-


n't fly, run, or jump, so the dog police took a giant needle and popped him. Also the kid made it out safe and the dog police caught him.
